PROTOCOL AT THE FESTIVE BOARD

PROCESSION INTO THE FESTIVE BOARD

Marshal Worthy Knights, would you please stand to receive the Most Puissant Sovereign,

ACCOMPANYING the Right Illustrious Intendant-General or

the Very Illustrious Deputy Intendant-General.

In ALL other cases, the format is:-

Marshal Worthy Knights, would you please stand to receive the Most Puissant Sovereign,

ACCOMPANIED BY (for example) the Divisional Eusebius (etc.).

WINE-TAKING

Marshal Worthy Knights, the Most Puissant Sovereign would be honoured if:-

the Right Illustrious Intendant-General *or* the Very Illustrious Deputy Intendant-General

WOULD TAKE WINE WITH HIM.

Marshal Worthy Knights,

the Right Illustrious Intendant-General *or* the Very Illustrious Deputy Intendant-General

has expressed a wish to take wine with you all but on this occasion has requested

that you remain seated.

No knight, other than the Intendant-General or his Deputy, should take wine with all those present.

In ALL other cases, the format is:-

Marshal Worthy Knights, the Most Puissant Sovereign *[will be pleased] to TAKE WINE WITH

(for example) the Divisional Eusebius (etc.)

*[the phrasing can be changed to avoid repetition]

RECESSION FROM THE FESTIVE BOARD

Marshal Worthy Knights, would you please stand whilst the Most Puissant Sovereign,

ACCOMPANYING the Right Illustrious Intendant-General or

the Very Illustrious Deputy Intendant-General retires.

Marshal Worthy Knights, would you please stand whilst the Most Puissant Sovereign,

ACCOMPANIED BY (for example) the Divisional Eusebius (etc.) retires.
