### STEWARDS REQUIRED FOR THE NATIONAL CHURCH SERVICE

Dear Worthy Knights,

I am pleased to report that the preparations for the National Church Service are going well and that, thus far, over 260 guests will be attending.

Michael Caseman-Jones, who is the Lead Organiser from Mark Masons' Hall, has asked that we provide about 14 stewards on the day to assist with the smooth running of the operation. I am therefore asking for volunteers to please email my Deputy, V.Ill.Kt. Stephen Gregory, [mg51msg@gmail.com](mailto:mg51msg@gmail.com), with their names.

The final details will be communicated nearer the time by MMH but, in outline, the timings and duties are shown on the following page.

There should be enough stewards to allow for doubling up of duties and comfort breaks, etc.

## PROVISIONAL TIMINGS AND DUTIES – Details to be confirmed by MMH

To be confirmed

1. Stewards to be present on the car park to direct guests towards the stadium entrance;
2. Stewards near the corner of the stadium to direct guests to the stairs (*or lift for those with limited mobility*) to the stadium entrance on the first floor.
3. Stewards inside the stadium entrance to direct guests to the elevator or lifts inside the building to the Carlsberg Dugout on the fourth floor. MMH will have a manned desk on the fourth floor to register guests on arrival.

~08:45

4. Stewards to direct the IGs and Divisional Standard Bearers (*but not their partners*) to the bus parking area (*on the road by the merchandise shop*) to get a bus to the Cathedral for a 09:30 rehearsal.  
*Journey time ~15 minutes*

~10:15

5. Stewards to get the guests on the buses to go to the Cathedral. It is important that the buses are full otherwise we may end up leaving guests behind! The Stewards and their partners will depart with their busload.  
On arrival at the Cathedral, direct the guests to the Cathedral entrance.  
*Journey time ~15 minutes*

~12:15

6. Stewards to direct the guests back onto the buses for the trip back to Anfield.  
*n.b. there may be more buses going back than arrived, as a number of guests will either be staying in Liverpool on the Friday night or arriving by train in the morning. They will make their own way to the Cathedral in the morning.*

~12:30

7. Stewards to direct guests (*especially those not at Anfield in the morning*) back to the Carlsberg Dugout on the fourth floor.

~15:30

8. Guests depart. There will be a bus to take guests back to the station (*which will also be the drop-off point for those staying another night in the city*).
